## Ash die back: This picture was taken on the

roadside between Brockbridge and Merringtons. It is caused by a fungus which infects both old and young trees and causes leaves to die back and the crown of the tree to become bare with lens-shaped

lesions which occur on the bark of the infected branches. First detected in the UK in 2012, it is becoming widespread. There are many sightings in the parish of Droxford and as the tree weakens it could cause danger. More info:




